Your favor of the 19th just come duly to hand & in reply I will say to you that it will afford me much pleasure to give you my aid in obtaining the office. Ascertain from Moore will appoint & then without delay I will comply at once with your request. I wrote him two letters to learn whether or not we would have Court - or in other words whether or not he would appoint a judge & he wrote back to the Clerk that the "Hon Porter King is now in the Army & that there will be no Court". I don't understand this & shall not write any more to him about Courts unless I know he will make an appointment. I will just say here that our Clerk is a very intelligent gentleman & I presume he was aware of all the facts that his ex-
