State of Alabama

The undersigned petitioners of
Jefferson County would respectfully represent unto
Your Excellency that at the February Term A. D. 1857 of
the Circuit Court of Jefferson County Henry A. Little was convicted
of an Assault & Battery upon the body of one David Larrys
and fined one hundred and thirty three dollars besides the
Costs of the prosecution. Your petitioners further represent
unto your Excellency that the Assault & Battery Consisted of
Beating David Larrys by Henry A. Little while the former
was lying down under the influence of intoxicating liquors.
Your petitioners further represent unto your excellency
that there was no serious damage done the person of the said
David Larrys, that the said Little was not actuated by the
principles of Malice to commit the Assault & Battery and
that the Beating was done through Spat & Jew.

Your petitioners further represent unto your Excellencies
that Henry A. Little is a Young man, and inexperienced
and of limited means, and unable to pay the said fine
without a great sacrifice; and that since the time
the said fine was assessed against him, he has become
a changed man, and undergone a considerable reformation.
Your petitioners are of the opinion that the fine
of one hundred and thirty three dollars is excessive and
should be reduced to the sum of Twenty five dollars
and which, together with the Costs of the prosecution
your petitioners think is sufficient fine and punishment.
In view of the foregoing facts your petitioners
pray your Excellency to reduce the fine of one
hundred and thirty three dollars to the sum of
Twenty five dollars And as in duty bound &c
