J. R. Mayo who was convicted at the October Term 1856 in the City Court Mobile of embezzlement, and sentenced to three years imprisonment in the Penitentiary is pardoned and the balance of his term of imprisonment remitted - upon the following grounds - to wit - The punishment is greater in my opinion than the character of the offense & the public good requires - He has served two years & two months of his term of imprisonment - His conduct has been unexceptionable & Judge McKenstry who sentenced him recommends his discharge with other petitions - He also promises to leave the state - For these reasons an order for his discharge is directed to be made out
