

To His Excellency Andrew B. Moore  
Governor of the State of Alabama.

The undersigned citizens of Alabama and residing in Barbour County, in behalf of Jacob Pamer who was at the last term of the Circuit Court for said County convicted of larceny from the person, respectfully petition your excellency, and pray that he may be released from imprisonment in the penitentiary to which he has been sentenced for three years under the conviction as above set forth. And they respectfully shew unto your excellency:

1. That said Jacob Pamer has been raised in Barbour County, and for a long time peacefully and favorably known to most of the undersigned.
2. The undersigned do not believe that the said Jacob Pamer is guilty of the offence of which he has been convicted, though he was unable or failed from some cause to make the necessary proof. They believe he has fallen the victim of a man, James, de Lane, on whose testimony he was convicted, and the man from whose person the property is alleged to have been taken, whose continued habits of long dissipation rendered him in their opinion incompetent to testify in a Court of justice in any case, much less one involving the liberty and reputation of a citizen.

For these reasons, more fully set forth in the affidavits accompanying this



petition, the undersigned pray your Excellency to pardon the said Jacob Parmer of the offence of which he has been convicted, and that he may be restored to his family and to society of which he was once a useful member.
