It being made known to me,
that a forfeiture was taken again
- At Burril Miltan, ^{from his person} in the Circuit
Court of Coosa County, a forma-
tion of said ^{and} as bail for his
son Abel J. Miltan, who was
indicted for larceny - ~~for~~
fifteen hundred dollars
I have remitted five hundred
dollars of said forfeiture for
the following reasons - When
said Abel J. Miltan was in
prison he made his escape,
went to the house of Burril
Miltan his father, who notified
to the Sheriff of Coosa County
that his son was at his house,
in consequence of this infor-
- mation he was arrested, &
put in prison again -
- The debt was afterwards
paid by Burril Miltan

And one McPherson - Petitioner
having procured said McPherson
to go on the said bail bond
by giving him a lien on
his land his only property of
any value - ~~for~~ the further
reason that it is represented that
other persons have induced the
young man to leave the state
against the wishes of his
father - I am also informed
that the old man has made
efforts to get his son back

I know Burrell Williams
personally & have known
him for many years - He is
now seventy-five years old
was a good soldier in the
late war with Great Britain
& is now very feeble - When
a citizen of my county when
I knew him well, he was known
as an honest & good citizen
for the above reasons I remit our
share of the forfeiture \$500 -
