Mr. Julius Loewenthal was convicted at the June term 1858 of the City Court of Embezzlement & sentenced to the Penitentiary for four years. Mr. Loewenthal is I am informed a native of Germany and came from Antwerp here; his parents I am informed are very respectable people, very old and infirm. I have seen his wife frequently - she seems to be an excellent woman and is certainly devoted to her husband's fortunes. She says that if Mr. Loewenthal is discharged they will at once return to Belgium. Mrs. Loewenthal will tell you more of the particular circumstances than I can write, and I am satisfied she will speak truly what she knows. From all I have learned from her and others I have determined to recommend Mr. Loewenthal to your clemency, and let me hope that ~~his wife~~ you will restore him to his wife.
