to wit, The wife of said ^{Macon} urges

& the only property out of which
the money can be made is their
land which is advertised to be
sold to pay the fine of \$200.
- It was his wife upon whom
the offence was committed.

The jury who convicted ^{him} ask for
his relief - together with a large
number of respectable citizens
many of his neighbors - The
Sent of State is directed to make
out the proper order to the Sheriff
of Coosa County
