To His Excellency Andrew D. Moore Governor
of Alabama
Dear Sir

The undersigned
Citizens of Pallas County, referent to
your excellency, that Andrew Gunn was
convicted in the Circuit Court of Pallas
County in the year 1847 of Murder and
sentenced to be hanged, and that pun-
ishment commuted to imprisonment for
life in the Penitentiary. He has been
now confined nearly twelve years, and
has reached his 68th year. We are
pleased to see from the recommendation &
Certificate of the Inspectors of the
Penitentiary, that his conduct as a
prisoner has been unexceptionable and
and exemplary, and do not doubt
that he has undergone a complete reformation.
Regarding his good conduct and
his extreme old age we agree with the
Inspectors of the Penitentiary that the
Remission of the remainder of his term
would not be inconsistent with the
public good. His extreme old age
surely renders him a public charge and
expense and his life must be near
its close. His son a most excellent
and much respected merchant of
Toussaint is here, and anxious to

to take his old Father with him to that
State and Comfort him in his last hours

In Commemoration of these things
We respectfully ask your Excellency to remit
the balance of his imprisonment
