administrators firm by these presents.
Sealed with ~~our~~ ^{our} seals and dated this 12th
day of April one thousand eight hun-
dred and ~~fifty~~ ^{eighty} one.

The condition of the above obligation
is such that whereas the above bound
George M. High did, on the 12th day of
April A. D. 1861, as by his contract in
writing of that date with Andrew
B. Moore Governor of the State of Ala-
bama, agree to give bond and security that
the solidity and substantiality of a certain
building therein specified, called a powder-
house, together with its roof, should be war-
ranted for five years after completion.
Now if the said George M. High his
heirs, executors administrators shall
and does well and truly build and

Contract said Powder House according
to the plan & specifications hereto
annexed, in a workmanlike manner,
keep the roof free from leaks, and
warrant the building & the roof to be
kept in good condition for five years
from the said 1st May of 1896 next
then this obligation to be void and
of no effect, otherwise to remain in
full force and virtue in law.
