

The State of Alabama
Know all men by these Presents
That the State of Alabama acknowledges
itself to owe and be indebted to the
Central Bank of Alabama, in the sum
of One hundred Thousand Dollars
being the amount borrowed by me as
the Governor of said State from said Cen-
tral Bank on the First day of February 1861
under the provisions of an Act of the General
Assembly of said State approved 25 Janu-
ary 1861, and entitled "An Act, to provide
for the payment of the Members and Officers
of the General Assembly and of the Delegates
and Officers of the Convention of the People
of Alabama now in session at Montgomery
and for other purposes" which said sum
of One hundred Thousand Dollars,
together with the interest thereon at the
rate of eight per centum per annum
from the said First day of February 1861
is due and payable to said Bank or its order
at the Office of the State Treasurer on the
First day of June in the year 1862

In witness whereof I Andrew
B. Moore Governor of said
State have signed this obli-
gation and caused the same
the same to be countersigned
by the Comptroller of Public
Accounts, and the Great Seal
of the State to be affixed on
this the First day of February
