a judgment final on a forfeited
recognisance was rendered against
John C. Hill for two hundred dollars
- The deft appeals to the Executive
to relieve him from the forfeiture
for reasons set forth in his petition
and upon the further ground
that he has entered into another
~~bond~~ - I have determined to
order the execution on said ^{judgment}
to be suspended until the next
term of the Circuit Court of said
County, & if deft comes forward and
stands his trial, & submits to the
judgment of the Court - said forfeit-
ure will be set aside
